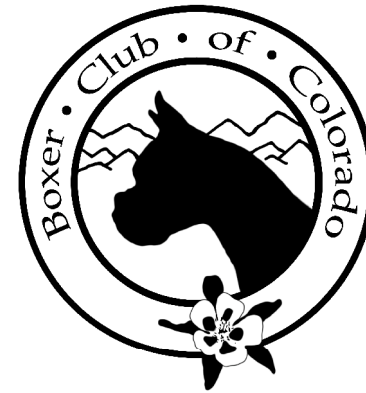

Exhibitors will be subject to disciplinary action by the Boxer Club Of Colorado, Inc. Show Committee for any reported damages (including failure to scoop poop). Do not allow your dog to destroy or foul rooms. Put plastic under your crates. The American Kennel Club will be notified of any destruction/soiling of hotel grounds or property. You are REQUIRED to clean up area after walking your dogs on a leash at any hotel/motel. DO NOT leave dogs unattended inside any motel room. Please crate your dogs while they are in the room. DO NOT groom your dog inside rooms.

NOTE: The Novice breed class is NOT offered at this show.

NOTE: The Junior classes are adult class and require an adult entry fee.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single-Dog Entries

Veterans – for dogs and bitches 6 years and over.

Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show. Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males and spayed bitches may be entered in the Veteran Class at independent Specialties.

Best Puppy in Regular Classes: For 1st place winners in the Regular Puppy classes following Best of Breed Competition.

Best in Veteran Class: For 1st place winners in the Veteran classes following Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

(Winners of multiple entry classes are not eligible to compete in BOB by virtue of winning these classes)

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two, but not more than 4, of their Get. Get must be entered in a regular class at this show. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get.. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed bitches are allowed to be entered in Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Classes..

Open to all Boxers that are between 6 months and less than 18 months of age on the day of the show. Entrants may be shown by owners or agents and may be a Champion of Record as of the date of closing. ALL BOXERS ENTERED IN SWEEPSTAKES MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS AT THIS SHOW. Enter by writing 'Sweepstakes' and the age division under Additional Classes on the entry form. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes.

The following classes will be offered for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy, 6 Months and Under 9 Months ♦ Puppy 9 Months and under 12 Months
Junior 12 Months and under 15 Months ♦ Junior 15 Months and under 18 Months

1st place winners of Sweepstakes Classes will compete for: Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best in Junior Sweepstakes. Best Puppy and Best Junior will compete for Grand Sweepstakes Winner

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

"A recording fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 AKC Event service fee per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club." (Ch 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules).

Island Grove Regional Park and the City of Greeley have imposed a \$1.50-fee-per-dog entered at all its events. These fees are used for park improvements.

Entries **CLOSE WEDNESDAY, 7:30 pm (MST) August 19, 2015** or when numerical limits have been reached, if reached prior to this date and time, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

A judging schedule will be mailed to each entrant as soon as practical after the closing of entries.

Email notification of entry received will be sent to each exhibitor as soon as possible by the show secretary.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT FEES IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of a Show Committee. A refund of \$4.00 or less will not be returned due to the costs of processing. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BCOC will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in them being put on a CASH-ONLY basis.

No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make an effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Owners and agents are responsible for errors in completing entry forms. Whoever may make such errors, no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

The Boxer Club of Colorado, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official American Kennel Club Entry Form for this event.

The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information on the entry form. Entries will not be accepted without fees and signatures. Entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form, or photocopy of the Official AKC Entry Form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side, or they cannot be accepted. Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog provided they are at least 18 years old and neither own nor co-own the dog. The Denver Samoyed Association, Inc., the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for children.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging, and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club, nor the Show Secretary will be responsible nor obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds. No double handling will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

SHOW SITE INFORMATION:

The show site will be available to exhibitors for parking from 1:00 to 10:00 PM On Thursday, September 3.. No building will be available for grooming set-up until 4:00PM on Thursday, September 3.. The Building will be open from 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm on Thursday, September 3, and 7:00 am to 10:00 pm on Friday, September 4.. The site will again be available at 6:00 am to 10:00 pm on Saturday the 5th. Sunday, September 6, from 6:00 am. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following "Best in Show" judging on Sunday, September 6, 2015.

DOGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED OVERNIGHT IN THE BUILDINGS. All Dogs must be removed from the buildings by 9:30 PM each Night. No Security will be provided from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

No generators to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.

No unentered dogs allowed on grounds during show hours.

PLEASE, NO BABY STROLLERS IN THE SHOW BUILDINGS.

Exercise pens in livestock barn only.

Crates must be stacked whenever possible.

Grooming will be available in the following buildings or outdoors: Exhibit Hall and Exhibition Building. Reserved paid grooming will be available in the Exhibit Hall and Exhibition Building Only. There is no longer a Livestock building on the grounds.

There is ample grooming space. Roping off an area or saving spaces will not be allowed unless authorized by the show committee. This will be strictly enforced.

A crate holding area will be available & marked in the community building. Exhibitors may use this area a few minutes before to immediately after their breed is judged. Grooming, scissoring, etc. will not be permitted in this area.

A returned check fee of \$25.00 will be charged for returned checks (exhibitors & vendors).

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are exhibiting or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site. Clean up tools and supplies are the responsibility of each Specialty Club.

No dogs may be left unattended in soft sided crates. Dogs must be in control at all times. This includes the use of Flexi-leashes.

BCOC and/or ECKC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE OR CRATE ANY WAY NECESSARY. BCOC and/or ECKC SOLELY DETERMINES IF SAID ANIMAL IS IN DISTRESS. ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

Note: Unawarded Sweepstakes class placement prize money, from classes with less than four entries, will be divided equally among the Sweepstakes class placements. The division of unawarded prize money will not include prize money not awarded due to absences.

TROPHY INFORMATION:

The BCOC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

General Parking Instructions

For Island Grove Park - Specialties & All Breed Shows

Additional Show Site and Parking Information is in the ECKC Show premium. This premium is available at www.onofrio.org.

THE ONLY ENTRANCE INTO THE SHOW SITE WILL BE OFF 11TH Ave (14th Ave will be closed at "A" St.)

LOADING & UNLOADING AREAS: 10 MINUTE TIME LIMIT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE VEHICLES UNATTENDED. VEHICLES IN NO PARKING, FIRE LANES, OR 20 FT. FROM A FIRE HYDRANT WILL BE TICKETED OR TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.

DAY PARKING: The paved lot south of the stadium (approx one block from the exhibition building) is available for day parking. There are no hookups in this lot. Additional day parking is available **FREE OF CHARGE** on the east side of the park & west of the show buildings. These are gravel lots. All RV's must be in their site by 8:00 PM on Friday.

The club assumes no responsibility for personal injury or death of any person; theft, injury or death of any animal; or damage to or loss of any property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show.

OVERNIGHT PARKING: Will be available on the show grounds. This parking is a privilege extended by the ECKC & this privilege can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow these rules, regulations & instructions of the club members, officers & guards on duty. Any breach of these terms will be reported to the Show Committee. The fees are charged to help defray the costs of the security guards.

Overnight parking will be available beginning at 1:00PM on Thursday, September 3. Anyone parking prior to this time will need to pay an additional fee to the City of Greeley per day (check in at Island Grove Regional Park, 501 N 14th Ave. 7:00 am to 3:30 pm, Monday through Wednesday). You will be asked to move if not in your reserved spot on Friday before 10:00 am.

- No overnight parking in the park without a paid fee.
- No parking refunds after closing date.
- All overnight parking with electric & specific location is based on breed(s) shown & time & date of receipt of reservation request – by mail or on site.
- All units must be self-contained. Exhibitors will be responsible for clean up of their areas. Trash dumpsters will be provided.
- No discharge of greywater or sanitary tanks is permitted. A RV dumpsite is available near the show grounds north of the Stampede Arena Thursday through Sunday, 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- All set-ups must be made within your assigned space.
- No vehicles longer than 50 feet will be parked in the oval.
- Any vehicle with a pop out must have cones (provided by the owner) placed beneath the pop-out portion.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW SITE:

**Island Grove Regional Park , 11th Ave N & D St, Greeley, Colorado 80631
Enter Park Via 11th Ave**

From I-25- Take the Highway 34 Greeley exit and go east to 35th Avenue. Turn left (north) and go to 10th Street. Turn right (east), and go to 14th Avenue. Turn left (north) and follow 14th Avenue into Island Grove Regional Park.

From Highway 85- Follow Highway 85 north into Greeley. Highway 85 turns into 8th Avenue. Go to 5th Street and turn left (west). Go to 14th Avenue, turn right (north) and follow 14th Avenue into Island Grove Regional Park.

RESERVED DAY PARKING

A RESERVED DAY PARKING AREA will be provided in the lot behind the show buildings. EACH VEHICLE MUST HAVE A PERMIT FOR THE SHOW WEEKEND.

NO GROOMING OR EXERCISE PENS WILL BE PERMITTED UNLESS AN ADDITIONAL SPACE IS PURCHASED.

COST: \$25.00 PER SPACE from Thursday 1:00 PM thru Sunday. In and Out will be allowed.

Reservation Deadline: Aug. 20th. After this date, parking must be paid in cash, at the gate.
